Greater Wellington Regional Council updates from Yadana Saw:

Transport: Half price fares for Community Services Card holders start on 1 July. The Community Connect portal is now open for CSC holders to register here with your Snapper card and CSC numbers. https://snapperaccount.snapper.co.nz/concession There are free Snapper cards available for people who don't have one and want to sign up for Community Connect. Metlink will be ready to launch free public transport for Under 13s and half price fares for 13-25yrs on 1 Aug. The delay is due to the lack of an age-verification portal, we've never needed one until the Budget day announcements, so it's been very challenging for both Metlink and Snapper teams to build this by 1 July.
